October 30th 1915

Dear Mother,

I told you we came over in my last letter. I can give you an address now. This ambulance is attached to the 1st Division – that's where I am.

We had Wednesday night, Thursday and half Friday in a rest camp in Rouen. Last night I had, with 10 others in the train. I am quartered in a barn. We have straw for beds. Also I have a waterproof sheet to lie on. Besides an overcoat I have a rubber mackintosh.

I'm quite alright. This is short because I've only just arrived and I wanted to let you know what had happened and where I was.
