1938

A station is built at W.

The station platforms are lengthened.

Quickly realised that the original station is unable to cope with passengers needs.

A new station is planned

1840

A new station is built.

(land is acquired from Radcliffe trustees in this year - was it for station?)

Has kitchen, ice house, piggery, refreshment rooms

4 Lanes in the area of the station

Bletchley station is opened.

Branch lines are built through Bletchley. It rapidly becomes the more important station. Improvements in train mean that every journey does not need a servicing break necessitating a stop at W.
