Railroad Accident, - In consequence of an accident which befell the engine in the neighbourhood of Weedon, the London letters which were due at Liverpool at seven o'clock on Wednesday morning; did not reach their destination till half-past 12. It has been imagined that arrangements were made for the forwarding of a watching or relieving engine whenever the train was detained beyond one hour after the time at which it was expected to arrive. It would seem, however, either that the plans of the directors are not matured, or that their orders have been neglected, - *Liverpool Paper*.
