(EXEUNT. PUSHED BACK ON STAGE IMMEDIATELY IN CUSTODY OF TWO POLICEMEN, GODFREY AND WARREN. THE SCENE IS NOW THE COURT AT THE LOCAL ASSIZES. ENTER GEORGE BERRILL, MARK CAUCUTT AND MR. BURY, LOCOMOTIVE SUPERINTENDENT AT WOLVERTON WORKS.)
