Corporal M. Turk who was the first to go into the dug-out to rescue your son, has been awarded a bar to his military medal which he got rescuing wounded under heavy shell fire.

A Captain Donald of No 1 F Amb. Was also awarded the military cross for being concerned with the rescue of your son.

During the last twelve months the ambulance has had fairly moderate casualty list.

One of these a chum of your son's has had a wounded arm, a fracture I believe and is now in Newcastle.

Personally I am in the best of health, and spirits too as far as circumstance permit.

All your son's friends including Capt McTurk and myself send you best wishes.
