

Nora Emily now became the tenant of Well House together with her husband Tom, but by this time, Well House was owned within the family following its purchase in 1949 by Nora's cousin (see above section 1), Harold B Wallis, for the benefit of his relatives. Harold was the son of Sarah Jane Wallis (nee Jones) and her husband Cyrus Wallis. Sarah was Louisa Hannah Garner's (nee Jones) sister and hence Nora Emily's Aunt.

Nora Emily died in 1968, age 62yrs. and Thomas continued to live there until his death in 1981 age 72 yrs. An earlier letter dated 23rd Sept. 1975 had informed Thomas that Well House "was selected for inclusion in the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historical interest compiled by the Secretary of State for Department of the Environment". Well House had become a "Grade II listed building".

After Thomas Robinson's death there were no members of the Jones/Garner family remaining in Bletchley, hence Well House was sold in 1981 thereby ending a one hundred and sixteen year period of occupancy of Well House by the Jones/Garner family members.
